If load exceeds any of these dimensions or weights, refer to the section on Super Loads.

Must be registered for the weight you are hauling. The maximum weight the state allows you to register your IRP cab card is 160,000 lbs.

PERMITS VALID FOR

Single trip permits are valid for five (5) consecutive days (excluding Saturday & Sunday).

ACCEPTABLE PERMIT FORMAT

The driver shall carrier a signed, pager copy of the permit in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspection by any police officer or agent of the Department of Transportation.

EXTENSIONS/REVISIONS

None allowed.

OPERATING TIME

Sunrise to sunset. Overweight only may travel 24/7.

WEEKEND TRAVEL

Weekend travel allowed if overall dimensions do not exceed 10' wide, 14' high, or 90' long. Saturday and Sunday daylight hours until 3:00pm.

The weekend travel allowance will not be applied to modular or mobile home movement since section 257.719a (2)(5) of the Michigan Vehicle Code specifically prohibits it.

LIFT AXLES

Lift axles must be full weight bearing axles. Vehicles must have air or lift axles on the ground.

DIVISIBLE LOADS

Will allow as long as weight remains legal and the additional item does not create the overdimension.

EXCEPTIONS

Loads may be hauled with blades and counterweights etc., attached. Blades and counterweights that are part of the equipment can be hauled with the load. Buckets and drag line components must be hauled separately. Prefabricated items (structural steel, trusses, tanks, etc.) limited to 16' wide, 15' high, and 150' long.

SELF-PROPELLED EQUIPMENT

Permits for 2 axle rubber tired scrapers or loader self-propelled equipment will be issued but not to exceed 850 lbs. per inch of tire width.

INTERMODAL

Must be legal.

MANUFACTURED HOUSING/MOBILE HOMES

Mobile home or building modules will not be permitted over 16' wide not including 6" leaves, 15' high, 80' body length, or 105' overall length.

Maximum gauge of mobile home or vehicle transporting a module to be 9'6" or less from center of wheel to center of wheel. Towing unit must be at least 1-1/2 ton truck with dual wheels.

The movement of an oversize mobile home requires the display of six (6) clear, plain red flags at least 18" square. One flag shall be displayed on each end of the front bumper of the towing vehicle and shall be supported on a short staff at an angle so as to wave freely. One flag shall be displayed on each corner of the mobile home or building module placed so as to be clearly seen by approaching traffic.

In the case of a breakdown or unavoidable delay, an attempt shall be made to remove the building from the highway. If it cannot be removed, it shall be clearly marked with warning lights and shall be attended by personnel to assist in directing traffic.

Two "Oversize Load" signs of black block lettering on Interstate Yellow background. One 6' x 16" sign with 12" lettering on front bumper of the towing vehicle and one 8' x 18" sign with 16" lettering on rear of the load not less than 7' above the highway.

Extended Permits Specific loads moved frequently on state highway Right-of-Way may qualify for renewable, extended permits available for loads and vehicles owned and operated by the applicant or under a bona fide lease/rental agreement. Loads and vehicles shall be described specifically by make and model, and serial and/or VIN number. Extended permits are not available to "for hire" carriers.

MICHIGAN

Example 1:

Ms. Glad's existing oversize permit expires on the first day of August.

Move horizontally across the top row of the chart until you find the month of August.

Then, move down the August column until you get to the first letter in Ms. Glad's name (G).

The new extended transport fee for the oversize permit (prorated this year only) is \$47.00.

The new extended transport expiration month for this oversize permit is March.

This one-time-only \$47.00 prorated permit fee will extend the extended transport expiration date for this oversize permit two years from the current year.

Example 2:

Mr. Nice's existing overweight permit expires on the first day of June.

Move horizontally across the top row of the chart until you find the month of June.

Then, move down the June column until you get to the first letter in Mr. Nice's name (N).

The new extended transport permit fee for the overweight permit (prorated this year only) is \$125.00.

The new extended transport expiration month for this overweight permit is September.

This one-time-only \$125.00 prorated permit fee will extend the extended transport expiration date

*Route Survey: Applications for permit in excess of 13'6" in height shall certify that the proposed route has been traveled to assure vertical clearance.

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Passenger car or pickup truck with at least one flashing/rotating amber light on top of the vehicle. In addition, there will be displayed on the roof of the escort vehicle one "Oversize Load" sign 5' x 12" with 8" high black letters on yellow background. If the width of the vehicle exceeds 14', front and rear vehicles will be required to have radio communication between the escort vehicles and towing vehicle. If the height of the vehicle exceeds 14'6", the escort vehicle will be required to have a fixed measuring device set at a height to assure clearance of the load. At least two (2) flashing or rotating amber lights to be placed on the extreme rear of the load. All flashing or rotating amber lights to be visible for a distance of 500'.

Signs, Flags**SIGNS**

Oversize and overdimensional load movement will require the vehicle to be equipped with two "Oversize Load" signs, 7' long by 18" high with 10" black letters on yellow or orange background. One sign on the front of the vehicle, the other on the rear of the load.

FLAGS

Flags shall be red or orange and at least 18" square, displayed at each of the four corners of the vehicle or load. If any portion of the load extends beyond the width at the corner flag, one additional flag shall be displayed at the widest point on each side of the vehicle or load.

Flags shall be securely fastened by at least one corner or securely mounted on a staff.

Insurance

Not required to be on file. Must carry minimum insurance of \$750/500/10 for all ICC carriers.

Restricted Travel

The following counties are restricted for loads over 12' wide, 90' long from 7:00-9:00 A.M. and from 3:00-6:00 P.M.:

Towing vehicle must be at least 1-1/2 tons with dual wheels. Permit not valid for movement when wind velocity exceeds 25 m.p.h. (mobile homes only)

Mackinaw Bridge - must notify authorities 24 hours prior to movement. (906) 643-7600.

Blue Water Bridge - must notify authorities 24 hours prior to movement. (810) 984-3131.

Ambassador Bridge - must notify authorities 24 hours prior to movement. (313) 989-0136.

International Bride - Advance notice is required for vehicles over 12 ft wide and/or 144,000 lbs (68,040 kg), and vehicles over these limits need an escort to cross the bridge. Escorts for loads over 13 ft 6 in wide require that the bridge be closed to oncoming traffic. Temporary, lower restrictions could be in place based on construction and other needs. Check requirements before traveling across bridge. (906) 635-5255 ext. 0

Drivers going into or coming out of the following ports will be required to have a Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC) issued by the Transportation Safety Administration:

Alpena, Bay City, Calcite, Detroit, Escanaba, Marine City, Marquette, Muskegon, Sault St. Marie, St. Ignance, Traverse City

SPRING WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Usually February to April normal maximum axle weights allowable on rigid pavements shall be reduced 25% and the maximum wheel load shall not exceed 525 lbs. per inch width of tire. On flexible pavements the maximum axle weights are reduced 35% and the maximum wheel load shall not exceed 450 lbs. per inch width of tire. No overweight permits are issued during spring frost restrictions.

Holidays

Travel is prohibited on the following holidays:

New Year's Day	Independence Day	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Labor Day	Christmas Day

The State Permit Office will be closed on the above mentioned holidays as well as Martin Luther King Day, Lincoln's Birthday, Juneteenth Day, Veteran's Day, the day after Thanksgiving and the day after Christmas, but travel will not be restricted on these additional days.

Fines

Fines are; \$.03 cents per lb. for each load in excess of 1,000 lbs., up to an excess of 2,000 lbs. when the excess is 2,000 lbs. or less. 2,000-3,000 lbs. is \$.06 cents per lb.; 3,001-4,000 lbs. is \$.09 cents per lb.; 4,001-5,000 lbs. is \$.12 cents per lb.; 5,001-10,000 lbs. is \$.15 cents per lb.; 10,000 lbs. and over is \$.20 cents per lb.

Super Loads

Loads 16' wide, 15' high and/or 150' long are considered super loads.

The following information must be submitted in writing by the shipper: Description of load, number of pieces, load dimensions and overall dimensions, if overheight a statement certifying the route that has been surveyed, weight of object, origin and destination, routes, dates of move, reason the load cannot be reduced and name of transporter if known. Drawings required if more than 11 axles. Allow 1-10 days for approval. Overweight or loads over 14' wide will not be issued during spring thaw. Route survey must be on Michigan form # 2465.
