TOLERANCE

TIRE WIDTH

600 lbs. per inch width for steering axle and 500 lbs. per inch width for other axles.

ACCESS

Not applicable.

OVERHANG

Overhang cannot exceed 10'. No vehicle can exceed 70' with exception of 75' when including overhang.

EXEMPTIONS

The provisions with respect to maximum width do not apply to implements of husbandry incidentally operated, transported, moved or towed over a highway. If an implement of husbandry is transported or moved as a load on another vehicle over 1.) a highway which is part of the national system of interstate and defense highways if the load exceeds 8'6" in width or 2.) any other highway if the load exceeds 10' in width.

The vehicle and load must not be operated for a distance of more than 25 miles from the point-of-origin of the trip and must not be operated at a speed in excess of 30 m.p.h.

Vehicles carrying a load of loosely piled agricultural products such as hay, straw or leguminous plants in bulk but not crated, baled, boxed or sacked, the load and any loading racks retaining the load must not exceed 10' in width.

Trip permits are reviewed on an individual basis only (length, width, height). Loads 17' wide or greater and 18' high and greater require special approval. If load exceeds any of these dimensions or weights, refer to the section on Super Loads.

PERMITS VALID FOR

Single trip permits are valid for five (5) consecutive days, one trip only.
Annual multiple-trip permits are valid for 12 months from date of issue.

ACCEPTABLE PERMIT FORMAT

If permittee has a paper copy must be signed to be valid. If shown electronically, the permit doesn't have to be signed but by showing it permittee agrees to the terms & conditions.

EXTENSIONS/REVISIONS

No extensions granted. Revisions only on the day permit ordered.

OPERATING TIME

One-half hour before sunrise until one-half hour after sunset for daytime travel.

Night travel will be given if maximum dimensions do not exceed 14' wide, 15' high, 110' long, 15' overhang.

WEEKEND TRAVEL

Night and Saturday/Sunday travel will be given for dimensions not exceeding 14' wide, 15' high, 110' long, 15' overhang.

No travel on I-15 between Las Vegas Exit 33/Blue Diamond and CA line if over 12' wide, 15' high, 110' long, 15' overhang on Sundays from 2pm – 10pm & from CA/NV Line I-15 to Exit 33/Blue Diamond on Fridays from 2pm – 10pm over 12' wide, 15' high, 110' long, 15' overhang. (Northbound on Fridays & Southbound on Sundays)

LIFT AXLES

No law regarding lift axles so if it is on the ground it is considered an axle and the tire width and the spacings will determine the weight.

DIVISIBLE LOADS

The Department will not issue permits for those vehicles or vehicle combinations and loads that are reducible in length, width or height.

Loads which are transported under authority of a permit shall be non-reducible in nature in length, width and height. This includes items of machinery, construction equipment, fabricated units, mobile cranes, off-highway trucks, earth moving equipment, etc. Blades or rippers attached to tractors are considered as part of the machine and therefore are non-reducible.

EXCEPTIONS

Blades do not have to be removed. If buckets or counterweights, they can be removed they should be; if overweight can haul as part of the load if is part of the load. .

SELF-PROPELLED EQUIPMENT

Each case is looked at individually. Axle spacings are required to determine the maximum weight allowed on an axle. Cranes may be issued multi trip permits if dimensions do not exceed 14' high, 90' long or 12' wide. All self-propelled applications must contain a self-propelled application and scale ticket with company's name and matching unit #.

INTERMODAL

It must be legal.

MANUFACTURED HOUSING/MOBILE HOMES

Evidence of insurance shall be furnished by the insurer - limits 100/300/50. Expiration or cancellation of this insurance will automatically void the permit. The permit shall become void when the length of a mobile home box exceeds 80'.

Movement of mobile homes in excess of 16' wide are not permitted.: In addition to the above special provisions, or restrictions pertaining to or attached to the transportation permits the following shall also apply: the minimum number of axles on the mobile and modular home shall be not less than one for each 6,000 lbs. of weight and shall be spaced to afford maximum stability, tracking and distribution of weight.

The combined braking force for towing unit and mobile and modular home shall be not less than 43.5% of the gross combination weight. The deceleration of the combination shall be not greater than 14' per second.

The braking distance shall be not greater than 50' at 20 m.p.h. The minimum tire size to be used on the mobile and modular home shall be not less than 8.00 x 14.5" 10-ply on all wheels.

The power unit used to tow an overwidth trailer coach or mobile home having a gross weight of 18,000 lbs. or less must be at least a 3/4-ton truck or tractor equipped with dual wheels. If it has a gross weight of over 18,000 lbs., the power unit must be at least a 1/2-ton truck equipped with dual wheels.

Types of Permits**Single Trip Permit \$25.00**

Generally issued for the movement of over-dimensional vehicles or vehicle combinations and loads.

Annual Permit \$60

Issued for farm machinery used in seasonal harvesting, construction type equipment, and special mobile type equipment, that does not otherwise conform to statutory requirements provided:

- 1.) Maximum width is no more than 14'.
- 2.) Maximum length does not exceed 110'.
- 3.) Maximum height does not exceed 15'.
- 4.) Maximum gross weight and axle loading will not exceed that established by evaluation of the application based upon axle configuration and overall length.
- 5.) Maximum overhang 25'.

The maximum length allowed on an Annual permit shall not exceed 110' unless we have a letter on file stating that they have a steerable rear axle, then they can go up to 120' long.

INFORMATION NEEDED TO ORDER PERMIT

Name of applicant, name of company, load description, tractor unit number, overall width, overall height, overall length, actual gross weight (if overweight, axle spacings), steer tire size (if overweight), overhang, origin and destination (address if stopping or starting in NV), routes, effective date and where to email the permit.

Mobile Homes:

Same requirements as above except no night travel allowed.

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

An escort shall have a minimum width of 60" and a minimum wheel base of 95", it shall be no larger than a 1-1/2 ton truck, and shall display appropriate warning signs. Signs shall be removed promptly upon completion of escort duty. Flashing lights when specified on the face of the permit must meet Nevada Highway Patrol requirements.

Signs, Flags**SIGNS/FLAGS**

All loads or vehicles in excess of 8'6" wide must display "Oversize Load" or "Wide Load" signs front and rear. When a wide load is transported the signs shall be promptly removed upon completion of work. The minimum size warning signs shall be have black letters 10" high of 1 5/8 inch minimum stroke on a yellow background. Warning signs shall be neat, clean and mounted securely. Signs shall be displayed only when necessary and "Oversize Load" shall have precedence over other signs in questions of which to use. Warning flags must be at least 18 inches square and solid red or fluorescent orange in color. Flags must be displayed:

1. Front & Rear corner of the vehicle
2. If load is wider than vehicle:
 - At each front & rear corner of the load
 - At any other location on the load that is necessary to identify the maximum width of the load
3. If rear overhang exceeds 4 feet in length:
 - At the center of the overhang if the overhang does not exceed 2 feet in width

FLAGGER

Flagpersons may be determined as being necessary in order to warn and direct approaching traffic, each flagman must be wearing a red jacket or vest and be equipped with a red flag and paddle reading "STOP" in white letters with red background. Flagpersons shall not be less than 18 years of age and have flagger certification.

Insurance

The permittee shall indemnify the State of Nevada and save it harmless from and against any liability for injury to persons or damage to property whether said property may belong to the State, to the Permittee or to third parties, which injury or damage is sustained by reason of any cause directly or indirectly resulting from the exercise of the privilege granted.

Buildings over 10' wide and all mobile homes require insurance certificates for the towing vehicle, policy number and effective dates. \$450,000 Total liability. Breakdown: \$100,000 injury or death of one person, \$300,000 injury or death of two persons, \$50,000 property damage.

Weigh Stations

No permanent weigh scales.

Restricted Travel

When traffic, weather or other conditions are determined by the State Department of Highways or policing agency to constitute a hazard, the permit may be temporarily suspended or restricted in use.

The following are special restrictions for wide loads on certain Nevada Routes under jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation: (Cannot use as bypass, must be delivering on the route)

SR28 From US 50 at Spooners Summit to Nevada-California state line: All loads exceeding 8'6" require front and rear escorts. Loads are not allowed.

US93 (Boulder Dam) from SR500 North of Boulder to Boulder Dam: Loads are not allowed.

SR160 From junction with State Route 159 (Blue Diamond Road) to Clark-Nye County Line.

SR207 From US 50 to SR 209 (Kingsbury Grade):

SR208 (Wilson Canyon) from US 395 to Yerington: Loads are not allowed.

SR225 (Owyhee Canyon) only from Wild Horse to the Nevada-Idaho border:

SR229 (Secret Pass) from I-80 to US 93: all loads exceeding 8'6" require front, rear escorts.

SR341 (Geiger Grade) from US 395 to US 50: Loads exceeding 8'6" require front and rear escorts.

SR431 (Mt. Rose Highway) from Timberline Drive to SR28: Loads exceeding 8'6" require front and rear escorts.

Trip permits have to be submitted for all loads traveling on restricted routes. Special permission will be limited to loads that must be delivered to destinations on or near the restricted route that cannot be reached using any other highway. If special permission is granted for loads exceeding the above limitations a one trip permit and front and rear escort will be required.

These restrictions are subject to change without notice. Usually updated annually. The basic rules governing escort vehicles and permits for loads exceeding legal width remain unchanged.

SPRING WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Frost laws from February 1, through April 30, (approximately). During this time certain routes are restricted for weight and if traveling on those routes you must be legal on your axles. These restrictions are updated annually. Updated lists are posted on NDOT's website nevadadot.com

Holidays

Travel restricted may apply on the following holidays:

Holiday travel is allowed for the following vehicles: Up to 14' wide, 15' high and 110' long with 15' overhang.

Over 12' wide will require pilot car restrictions

The State Permit Office will be closed on the above mentioned days as well as *Nevada Day, Juneteenth Day, and the day after Thanksgiving, but travel will not be restricted on these additional days.

*Travel is restricted on I15 between Las Vegas (exit 33) and California line if over 12' wide, 15' high and 110' long 15' overhang on Friday's from 2pm – 10pm if heading Northbound & on Sunday's from 2pm – 10pm southbound.

Fines

Carriers receiving repeated citations for violation of the permit conditions may, at the Department's discretion, after three such citations /violations have permit privileges suspended for up to 30 days as set forth in these rules and regulations.

Fines for weight range from \$10 up to \$.08 cents a pound for 10,000 lbs. and above.

Fines doubled during spring weight restriction- February through May.

Super Loads

Each load is reviewed individually and it depends on routes, overall dimensions and axle spacings. If the Department wants a special review, a drawing including axle spacings and weight will be required. Route surveys may also be required

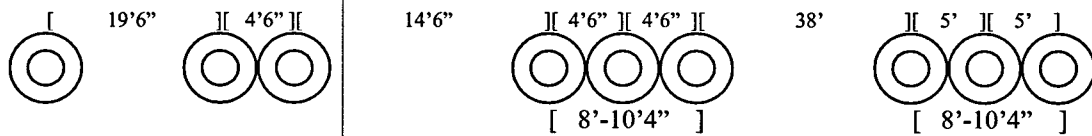

Element 1: Authorized tridem axle group. Must be 8' to 10'4" from the 1st axle to the 3rd axle in group.

Element 2: Tridem bonus weight authorized on only one authorized tridem axle group. In addition to Element 1, minimum of 18 ft. between any 2 axles of a tridem axle combination and the closest axle of any adjacent axle group (i.e., close coupling is not authorized). Bonus weight per chart above.

Element 3: Tridem bonus weight authorized on one or two authorized tridem axle group(s). In addition to Elements 1 and 2, minimum of 25 ft. between the centerline of any axle of a bonus weight tridem axle combination to the centerline of any axle of another bonus weight tridem axle combination. Maximum of two bonus tridems on any vehicle combination.

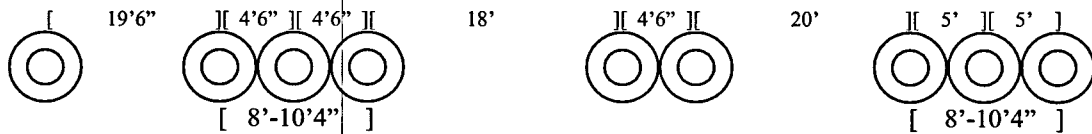
